**Ragging is totally prohibited in the institution**, and any one found guilty of ragging and / or abetting ragging, whether actively or passively, or being a part of a conspiracy to promote ragging, is liable to be punished in accordance with the Regulations as well as under the provisions of **one or more appropriate penal provisions namely –**

- 01) Abetment to ragging
- 02) Criminal conspiracy to rag
- 03) Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging
- 04) Public nuisance created during ragging
- 05) Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- 06) Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt
- 07) Wrongful restraint
- 08) Wrongful confinement
- 09) Use of criminal force
- 10) Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences
- 11) Extortion
- 12) Criminal trespass
- 13) Offences against property
- 14) Criminal intimidation
- 15) Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim (or victims)
- 16) Threat to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim (or victims)
- 17) Physical or psychological humiliation
- 18) All other offences following from the definition of "Ragging".

**Anti-Ragging Committee, Anti-Ragging squads, and Monitoring cells are constituted, as per the guidelines of the Government, in the college.**

Staff members and Law-abiding-students are advised to keep us informed, if they come across any kind of an act leading to Ragging in the campus or off the campus.

Before law-enforcing authorities (such as Police) swing in to action, Anti-Ragging Committee constituted by Principal is empowered to award one or more punishments (which are as follows), as per the guidelines of Government.

- 1) Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- 2) With-holding / with-drawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
- 3) Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process
- 4) With-holding results
- 5) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- 6) Suspension / expulsion from the hostel
- 7) Cancellation of admission
- 8) Rusticating from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- 9) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- 10) If specific persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, institute shall resort to collective punishment of the specific group.
